Sports Medicine ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR RECERTIFICATION

Introduction

ABEM diplomates who are certified in Sports Medicine through the American Board of Emergency Medicine (ABEM) are certified for a period of ten years. To recertify for another ten-year period, they must apply for recertification, meet the eligibility criteria for recertification, and pass the Sports Medicine certification examination for the purpose of recertification, administered by the American Board of Family Medicine.

Eligibility Criteria

Physicians applying for recertification in Sports Medicine must fulfill the ABEM Policy on Medical Licensure.

Candidates for recertification in Sports Medicine must be diplomates of the American Board of Emergency Medicine.

Candidates for recertification in Sports Medicine must be or have been certified in Sports Medicine through ABEM.

Physicians whose Sports Medicine certificates have lapsed are former diplomates and can regain certification in Sports Medicine. Former diplomates may regain certification by taking the Sports Medicine certification examination.
