



# Become an Oral Examiner

## Criteria

---

- Completed an ACGME- or RCPSC-accredited EM residency
- Certified by ABEM and five years out from EM residency graduation
- Clinically active in the practice of EM
- Actively participating in the ABEM continuing certification process
- Possess [Oral Examiner Attributes](#)

## Time Commitment

---

- Selected nominees are offered a 3-year term with opportunities for reappointments based on participation and performance.
- Oral examiners must be available for one exam per year. Examiners are required to attend all necessary training sessions and must examine all days of an exam.
- A typical exam is four to five full days. New examiners must attend a one-day training session prior to their first exam.

- A professional colleague submits the [Examiner Recommendation Form](#)
- Examiner nominations are considered on a quarterly basis by the ABEM Board of Directors
