About the Certifying Exam

The ABEM Certifying Exam is the final step to becoming ABEM Certified. The Certifying Exam will allow you to demonstrate the skills and methods learned in training and apply them to real-world clinical scenarios to determine if they meet the high standards required for the independent practice of Emergency Medicine. 

- Room blocks have limited availability and are not guaranteed.
- ABEM recommends that you stay at the Hyatt House, a nearby hotel, or make plans to ensure you arrive at the Hyatt House lobby in time for your exam registration.
- ABEM recommends you arrive in Raleigh no later than the day prior to your examination date.
- It may not be possible to adjust your examination schedule to accommodate travel delays. ABEM recommends giving yourself ample time to travel to Raleigh in advance of your scheduled exam time.

The exam is held in person at the AIME Center in Raleigh, North Carolina. During your half-day exam session, you will complete 10 cases. There are two case types covering 8 content areas that make up the Certifying Exam.

Registration on Exam Day

On-site registration takes place at the Hyatt House Raleigh North Hills hotel on your exam day. Please arrive at registration on time and prepared for your exam. After registration at the hotel, a proctor will walk you (~0.1 miles / ~3 minutes) to the AIME Center. You will not be able to access the AIME Center without your proctor.

Gathering Room 2, Lobby Level

AM session registration is at 7:00 a.m. ET

PM session registration is at 12:00 p.m. ET

- The registration room is directly down the hall from the Hyatt House front entrance.
- Be sure to check the local weather forecast and pack appropriately. Umbrellas, rain coats, and other items can be kept in your assigned locker at the testing center
- Luggage, including computer bags and purses, can be stored for you in a complimentary secure room at the hotel.
- You will be provided with a bag to seal items such as cell phones, watches, headphones, and other “prohibited” items. You will store the bag in an assigned locker at the AIME Center. Please review the list of prohibited items below.
- You will be provided with a name badge and lanyard, which will include your exam schedule.
- You will be required to acknowledge the [ABEM confidentiality policy](#).

Prohibited Items

ABEM will provide all materials needed to complete the exam administration. If you bring any of the following items to registration, they must be placed in a provided sealed bag and placed in your assigned locker; they will not be accessible until after your exam is complete.

- Watches (smart or analog)
- Cell phones (must be placed on silent or turned off)
- Beepers or pagers (must be placed on silent or turned off)
- Cameras
- MP3 players, iPods, or any digital recorder or player (must be turned off)
- Google glasses or other devices that can be used for recording (must be turned off)
- Notes or reference materials
- Pens, pencils

Allowed Items

The following items can be stored in your locker and will be accessible during exam breaks:

- Snacks and beverages
- Medications and medical devices (e.g., prescriptions, cough drops, eye drops, nursing equipment)

Dress Code

For your exam, you may wear whatever is comfortable (scrubs or what you wear on shift are permitted).

- Closed-toe shoes are required
- No logos or institution names on clothing (if you have clothing with your institution name, you will be asked to cover the logo with tape)
- You will be required to wear your name badge provided at registration at all times.

Exam Schedule

- At registration, you will be provided with your individual exam schedule and assigned a proctor.
- Proctors are there to assist you, keep the exam on schedule, and answer any questions you may have during the administration.
